Fader subassembly

Faders are mounted to plug-in PC boards to facilitate easy assembly and maintenance. This document describes the standard faders. Upgrades are available at an additional cost.

For replacement, any 100mm audio taper stereo fader can be used, but some may need to be hand wired, and some may not match the taper properly. The original faders have a taper that closely matches the industry standard Penny & Giles faders, which are available as an extra cost upgrade.

First, install the load resistors and connectors on the PC board:

Then, attach the PC board to the fader as shown. Center the solder tabs as shown, and make sure the PC is tight to the fader, as shown in the rear view.
